SCOPE OF WORK:

- 1. Earthwork in excavation by mechanical means (Hydraulic excavator)/manual means in foundation trenches or drains.
- 2. Filling available excavated earth (excluding rock) in trenches, plinth, sides of foundations etc.
- Providing and laying in position cement concrete of specified grade excluding the cost of centering and shuttering.
- 4. Half brick masonry with non-modular fly ash bricks.
- 5. Excavating, supplying and filling of Red Soil.
- 6. Cement Plaster.
- 7. Finishing walls with waterproofing cement paint.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

- The work shall be carried out as per CPWD specification 2019 Vol-I & II with up-to-date correction slips. For the items which are not covered under CPWD Specifications; B.I.S. specifications shall apply. In this regard the decision of Engineer-in- charge shall be final.
- 2. Unless otherwise specified, the agreement rates for all items of work of the schedule of quantities are for all heights, depths, leads and lifts involved in the execution of work.
- 3. On account of security consideration, there could be some restrictions on the working hours, movement of vehicles for transportation of materials. The contactor shall be bound to follow all such restrictions and adjust the program for execution accordingly, for which nothing extra shell be paid.
- 4. The work shall be carried out in a manner complying in all respects with the requirements of relevant bye laws of the local bodies, Labour Laws, minimum wages act, workmen compensation act and other statutory laws enacted by Central Govt. as well as State Govt.



- 5. No residential accommodation shall be provided to any of the staff engaged by the contractor. The contractor shall not be allowed to erect any temporary set up for staff in the site.
- 6. No claims of the labours shall be entertained by the Department including that of providing employment, regularization of services etc.
- 7. All required register will be issued by Engineer-in-Charge/Executive Engineer duly marked in chronological order but the contractor will have to arrange all such registers/stationery etc.

 Nothing extra shall be paid on this account.
- 8. No claim whatsoever for idle labour, additional establishments, costs of hire and labour charges for tools and plants etc. would be entertained under any circumstances.
- 9. For the safety of all labour directly or indirectly employed in the work for the performance of the contractor's part of this agreement, the contractors shall, in addition to the provisions of Safety code and directions of the Engineer-in-charge make all arrangements to provide facility as per the provisions of Indian Standard Specifications (Codes) listed below and nothing extra shall be paid on this account.
 - (a) IS 3696 Part I Safety Code for scaffolds and ladders
 - (b) IS 3696 Part II Safety Code for scaffolds and ladders Part II ladders
 - (c) IS 764 Safety Code for excavation work
 - (d) IS 7969 Safety Code for storage and handling of building materials
 - (e) IS 5216:1982 code of safety procedures and practices in electrical works
- 10. The contractor shall take all precautions to avoid all accidents by exhibiting necessary caution boards and by providing red flags, red lights and barriers. The con-tractor shall be responsible for any accident at the site of work and consequences thereof.
- 11. Contractor shall be fully responsible for any damages caused to govt. property or allotter "property by his or his labor in carrying out the work and shall be rectified by the contractor at his own cost.
- 12. All taxes, Labour Cess etc., as applicable shall be borne by the contractor himself. The contractor shall quote his rates considering all such taxes including GST on works. Any recovery towards GST is notified by the competent authority, the same shall be affected and no claim what so ever shall be entertained by The Prakasam District Cooperative Central Bank Ltd., Ongole. The contractor shall quote his rates accordingly.
- 13. Chases, holes & drilling works etc. shall be done using power operated tools in the cost of contract.

 No extra will be paid for the same.
- 14. The agency shall restore back the premises and other articles provided by the Bank at the time of closure of the contract.

- 15. In the case of discrepancy between the schedule of quantities, the Specifications and/or the Drawings, the following order of preference shall be observed: -
 - Description of schedule of quantities.
 - Additional specifications and special conditions, if any.
 - Contract clauses of General conditions of contract for Central P.W.D. works.
 - CPWD specifications.
 - Architectural drawings.
 - Indian standards specifications/BIS. (vii) Sound engineering practice. Any reference made to any Indian standards specifications in these documents, shall imply to the latest version of that standard, including such revisions/amendments as issued by the Bureau of Indian Standards up to last date of receipt of tenders. The contractor shall keep at his own cost all such publications of relevant Indian Standards applicable to the work at site.
- 16. The contractor and /or his authorized agent should see the site order book every day and get the compliance of instruction given by the JE/AE/EE (E-I/C) as per time schedule.
- 17. In addition to the provisions of relevant clauses of the contract, the work shall also be open to inspection by the Engineer-In-Charge, NITAP and other senior officers of the bank and his authorized representative. The contractor shall at times during the usual working hours and at all times at which reasonable notices of the intention of the Engineer- in-Charge or other officers as stated above to visit the works shall have been given to the Contractor, either himself be present to receive the orders and instructions or have a responsible Site Engineer duly accredited in writing, to be present for that purpose Senior Officers of the bank shall also be inspecting the ongoing work at site at any time with or without prior intimation.
- 18. In order to ensure safe construction, following shall be adhered for strict compliance at the site:
 - (i) The work site shall be properly barricaded.
 - (ii) Adequate signage's indicating "Work in Progress Inconvenience caused is Regretted" or Diversion Signs shall be put on the sites conspicuously visible to the public even during night hours. These are extremely essential where works are carried out at public places in use by the public.
 - (iii) The construction malba at site shall be regularly removed on daily basis.
 - (iv) All field officials and the workers must be provided with safety helmets, safety shoes and safety belts.
 - (v) Proper MS pipe scaffoldings with work platforms and easy-access ladders shall be provided at site to avoid accidents. Necessary First-Aid kit shall be available at the site.

- 19. All the debris during the execution of work shall be cleared every now and then and site shall be kept clear by the contractor at all times.
- 20. The contractor has to make his own arrangements for the watch and ward of the materials and other installations till the installation / work is completely handed over to the department. No extra claim will be entertained on account of this. Any damage to the materials during or under storage will be to the contactors account.
- 21. No quantity deviation is permitted without written approval of the competent authority. Permissible deviation shall be sanctioned by the competent authority as per the agreement. Deviation beyond permissible limits shall be sanctioned by the competent authority as per the prevailing Local Market Rates only and the decisions of the bank is final and binding on the contractor.



ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

- 1. The bidder should have valid GST Certificate.
- 2. Bidder must have CPWD/any State PWDs class-V/above category/any central/state Govt organization class-I valid Registration Certificate.
